Banners

Pop up banners will only be allowed in the entrance corridor for breeders that have a listing in the visitor guide, no pop ups are allowed in the hall benching area. Banners fixed to your show pens are allowed for all. Please do not use tape on our drapes, thank you.

Fees

Entry fees are due within 24 hours of entry or by the end of offer/closing date, whichever is soonest. **Entries cannot** be cancelled without payment in full, when you tick to agree to the TICA rules you are agreeing to pay. Please only enter if you are certain. No payments will be taken on the door. No refunds, transfers or credits will be offered.

Late fees of £20 will applied to all entries not paid within 72 hours of entry.

Please note show rule 24.1 "entry shall be accompanied by the published fee. No entry fee or related charge will be returned except for failure on the part of the sponsoring club to hold the show as advertised..." This includes place holders.

Confirmations: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the confirmation slips issued, please check carefully. If you do not receive a confirmation email before the closing date, please contact the entry clerk.

Benching: The club will provide a double space (4ft x 2ft/120cm x 60cm) per 1st & 3rd cats entered, e.g 1 cat = 1 double space, 2 cats = 1 double space, 3 cats = 2 double spaces. Only cats from the same household may share. Benching will be traditional rows. Requests for benching preferences should be submitted at time of entry, no guarantee can be given of meeting all benching requests, but, we will do our very best. This is a 'bring your own pen' show, exhibitors will need to provide a suitable pen, such as a Sturdi pen, or similar that fits in the space provided.

Show times: Checking in from 8 am to 8.45am Saturday – 9.15am – 9.45am Sunday.

Judging will start at 9.15 am Saturday and 10am Sunday until all judging is completed.

Open to the public from 10am to 4pm and, in consideration of paying spectators, no cats may be removed from the show hall before 4pm without the show manager's permission.

There will be NO access to the venue on Friday 9th January 2026.

Health Requirements: This show is a NON-VETTED show. Up to date vaccination cards must be produced at check in. Vaccination cards must contain both the owner's and the cat's registered name and details. Vaccines must have been given at least 7 days prior to the show. The show manager reserves the right to remove any cat showing any signs of illness, mites, fleas, fungal infections, etc, in accordance with TICA rules. Cats from a household where there has been an infectious disease or fungal infection within 21 days of the show must not attend.

Any pregnant or lactating cat will be disqualified. Please ensure all claws front and back are clipped, prior to judging.

Registration: In order for a cat to be shown without a registration number, that cat must be eligible for registration and competition in TICA in the class in which the cat is to be shown. No entry shall be accepted without a TICA registration number unless documentation is provided with the entry that shows the entry is eligible for registration in TICA. Such documentation includes, but is not limited to the following: **a**. TICA litter registration; **b**. TICA breeder slip; **c**. Registration certificate from any association TICA recognises; **d**. certified pedigree from any association TICA recognises; **e**. Registration certificate of both of the parents of the entry by either **c** or **d** above. Documentation must be submitted with the entry form.

Kittens: Any kitten entered must be at least 4 calendar months old but less than 8 calendar months on the date of the show. Neutered kittens are eligible for entry.

Household pets: HHP's over 8 months of age must be neutered or spayed.

Catering: There is an onsite café that will be supplying hot & cold food and drink all weekend from 8am.

Travel: nearest train station is Spalding. Taxis are always outside the station.

Travelling by car: The show will be well signposted. Enter PE12 6ET into your satnav as this will bring you to the Springfields Outlet shopping, the events centre is just past the shopping centre on the right hand side. Car parking will also be clearly signposted.

Overseas visitors: The nearest pet-friendly airports are Heathrow, Gatwick or Manchester. Please note, the club is unable to provide any transport.

Hotels: There is no official show hotel, however, the nearest cat friendly hotel is:-

Travelodge Spalding, Springfields Outlet Centre, Camel Gate, Spalding, PE12 6EU www.traveldoge.co.uk This hotel is a 5 minute walk to the venue at the front of the Springfields shopping Outlet complex. There is another Travelodge just south of Boston 20 minutes away along the A16.

Show rules: TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and show committee. The official show rules may be obtained from TICA www.tica.org
